Establish a System for Administrative Penalties for Non-Parking
Offences within The City of Port Colborne

Whereas the City of Port Colborne has adopted By-law No. 6902/50/21
Being a By-law to Establish a System for Administrative Penalties for Non-
Parking Offences within the City of Port Colborne; and

Whereas at its meeting of February 14, 2023, the Council of the Corporation
of The City of Port Colborne approved the recommendations of the
Community Safety and Enforcement Department, By-law Services Report
2023-11 Subject: Administrative Monetary Tier Penalty; and

Whereas The City of Port Colborne considers it desirable to move from a
single penalty system to a tier penalty system; and


Whereas the City of Port Colborne considers it desirable and necessary to
amend By-law No. 6902/50/21 Being a By-law to Establish a System for
Administrative Penalties for Non-Parking Offences within the City of Port
Colborne; and

Now therefore the Council of The Corporation of the City of Port Colborne enacts
as follows:

1. That By-law No. 6902/50/21 Being a By-law to Establish a System
for Administrative Penalties for Non-Parking Offences within the
City of Port Colborne, be amended by deleting the reference to
“Schedules “B” to “L” and replacing it with Schedule “B” in the following
sections:

Section 2.3 – Administrative Penalty
Section 2.8 – Designated By-law
Section 3.1 - Designated By-laws
Section 4.1 - Penalty Notice
2. That Schedule “B” is hereby amended to include administrative penalties
for the Sewer and Drainage Works By-law No. 5228/134/08, as
amended.
3. That Schedule “B” is hereby amended to include a tier penalty system.
